- **PCA** – grant received 3 clinics over a 2 day period Friday, Saturday or Saturday, Sunday
- We looked at dates and thought Feb 18 and 19, 2011 would be first choice – although it is President's Weekend.
- We need to secure locations for clinics. A room or auditorium would be best that could seat 75-100 people with a screen for the slide presentation. Perhaps a high school or college venue. – Lindenwood, DeSmet, Chaminade, CBC? Justin Cutter has secured Lindenwood for the Saturday clinics, but still need a location for Friday evening.
 - Friday evening would be the advanced coaches clinic – perhaps we could have pizza and drinks provided by the chapter - Double-Goal Coach: Culture, Practices and Games

- Saturday morning at 9:30 am would be a new coaches clinic - Double-Goal Coach: Coaching for Winning and Life Lessons
This interactive workshop introduces PCA's Double-Goal Coach model and provides an in-depth review of the three principles around which it is built:
 - Honor the Game
 - Fill Emotional Tanks
 - Redefine "Winner"
- The Parent's clinic would be at 1pm. **The Second-Goal Parent: Developing Winners in Life through Sports**
Referring to the Double-Goal Coach's second goal, parents learn how to teach life lessons through sports, including:
 - Recognition of the three major stages of talent development in youth athletes
 - Engaging in empowering conversations with your children
 - Structuring a positive parent/coach relationship.
- PCA had suggested having some sort of a program or hands on clinic after the parent's clinic to be more of an incentive to attend.
- Liam Banks had offered to come and do parents clinics for the boys and girls if we could provide two gyms and that we could do a parents rule meeting during the kids' clinic. Judy suggested that Liam

come run a coaches clinic which he did for GOAL last year, so he is not interested in a repeat of that. Tamara is going to further explore Liam running the kids clinic on Saturday and coordinate with Justin and Lindenwood for space.
