As a Head Coach your player will have your Registration fee refunded if you can do one of two things

- 1. Designate the BNBA for A State Farm Good Neighbor Grant. As a Coach you can designate the BNBA as a recipient of one of your Volunteer Employee Good Neighbor Grant opportunities. If you do so and the BNBA receives the \$500 grant then we will refund you your child's registration fee
- 2. Provide a sponsor for your team. If your business or someone you know is willing to sponsor your team at the BNBA, you can receive your child's registration refunded after we receive the sponsorship payment. Volunteer Coach Background Checks:

All coaches need to create a user account and register online. If you are a parent and have an account, you will still need to go through the Coach Registration process. Log into your account, then go to the proper league to the left and register as a Coach. In the following years, you can log in with your account information to register.

Umpiring in the BNBA

Umpiring in the BNBA is a great part time job for your high school or college student. We train the umpires and give them help by allowing them to work with more experienced umpires. Umpires make \$25.00 per game. Games last one and a half to two hours. Umpires can work one or two games a night. Games are played beginning at 530 pm or 745 pm on weeknights and at 10:00 am or 12:15 pm on Saturdays. The 2017 BNBA Umpire Clinic is scheduled for Sunday, April 30, at 3:00 pm at the Central Catholic High School. There will be umpiring skills demonstrations and we will begin the umpire scheduling process
