Weather

In the case of inclement weather please check the website at www.flrevolution.com before coming to the fields. If a session is to be cancelled it will be posted on the website on the website at least 30 minutes prior to the session start time.

Tryout Information

Please arrive 30-minutes prior to your first scheduled tryout time. Registration tables will be set up set up at the field house all players need to check in and pick up the tryout number. The tryout number should be attached to the shorts and should be worn to all sessions. Each tryout session will last approximately 90 minutes

The Tryout

Player placement will be based upon the evaluation of the age group coach and the Director of Coach's assessment of the player.

The selection of players will be determined by the coaching staff and Director of Coaching. The primary objective of the coaching staff is to place each player on the most appropriate team, allowing for the greatest opportunity for development, success and fun.

To be selected for a FRSC Competitive team, players are highly encouraged to attend as many sessions as possible

Playing Up

It is FYSA's policy that all players compete at a level in which they are both physically and developmentally capable. If a parent and/or coach would like to request that a player be evaluated and considered to "play up" one age group, the player must complete the "Request to Play Up" form and be evaluated by the Director of Coaching and the age group coach.

The player must attend the tryout in their correct age and will be advised as to the status of their request after the DOC and age group coach have had the opportunity to observe the player.

Please keep in mind that FYSA must also approve any player to play up more than one age group. The club will handle these requests after the DOC and age group coach make their decision.

All decisions regarding players and team rosters shall be made by the Director of Coaching along with the Coaching Staff and shall be considered as final.

Next Steps

If you are accepted on a team you will receive notice from your Coach by Tuesday, June 7th. You will receive instructions on how to accept your spot online. This needs to be completed 48 hours from the time the email is sent. If it is not completed by then, it will be assumed you are rejecting your spot and an offer will be made to another player.

Once you have accepted your spot, your first installment of club dues is due and payable.

Upon registration first payment, the player and his/her family are then committed to the team and the Club for the entire playing year and are expected to fulfill all training, game, team fees and volunteer requirements. Registration Fees are non-refundable

FRSC has partnered with Score for our custom uniforms needs. There will be sizing opportunities during tryouts. There will be sizing questions registration page once you have been placed onto a team that you must complete in order to get the correct size uniform. The cost for uniforms this year is \$120.00 this will include three full uniform kits (jersey, shorts and socks) as well as a practice jersey and will be paid separate from the registration fee. This fee is NOT included in any financial assistance package the player may receive.

If your team has a paid coach you will be advised of this at tryout. All Coaches fees and expenses are in addition to the registration fee. You will be advised by the team manager in regards to the payments for the coaching fee.

Additional Costs

There are Expenses that are not covered by the FRSC Registration Fee. These would include such things as Coaching Fees (if applicable to your team), Tournament entry fees including Region and State Cup Fes, Coach's travel expenses, team supplies/equipment. Any fees associated with these expenses are determined by the Coach and team manager and will vary by team. The expenses will be communicated after tryouts via the Team Manager, a payment schedule for the expenses will also be set by the team. This fee is NOT included in any financial assistance package the player may receive.

Scholarships

Players whose family complete the Scholarship Application and provides a copy of all supporting documents and fits the financial eligibility profile will be considered. This does not include each players separate Team Fees or uniform costs. Recipients of Scholarships will be required to volunteer in excess of the minimum requirement.

Whole or partial scholarships may be available based on need and monies allocated to the Scholarship Fund.

Sponsorships

Teams are encouraged to obtain a sponsor to help offset these expenses. All sponsorship money Is paid to the club. The club will deduct the cost of the banner and plaque (as noted on the form) and the rest of the money will be placed into the team account. The team decides how to apply the sponsorship money.

Volunteer Hours

FRSC requires that 4 hours for each player be served as volunteer time throughout the season. You may also choose to pay the buyout fee of \$50 for each player, if you cannot work the allotted amount of time. You will be contacted by the volunteer director in regards to dates, times and duties.
